- 4 Tournament Series
- First rugby tournament at the RAC
- 12 HS Boys Teams including Portneuf from Idaho
- 8 HS Girls Teams including Portneuf
- Approximately 140 (2014 180) players participated
- Herriman HS and Lady Orem Stallions State 7s Champions
- Inaugural Pink 7s held at RAC



#### 2016 SPRING 15s

- Division Commissioners
- Varsity Boys MS (12 Teams) and SS (16 Teams— 3 Nevada) Divisions
- 9/10 Boys MS (6 Teams) and SS (5 Teams) Divisions
- Varsity Girls (7 Teams) Division
- 7/8 (7 Teams) Grade Division
- Approximately 1,600 (2015 1,800) players

- College students used extensively as referees





  - Boys open winners






# 2015 / 2016 INCOME






## 2015 / 2016 PROGRAM EXPENSES

### 2016 / 2017 UNIFORM GRANT

- Potential partner considering uniform sponsorship for UYR HS clubs
- A maximum amount per team TBD
- Teams purchase NEW jerseys using grant
- Requirements
  - Sponsor logo on front
  - Club logo on left chest
  - UYR logo on right sleeve
- UYR recommends 3-4 preferred vendors
- UYR pays vendor direct or reimburses club



### 2016 / 2017 LEVEL 200 GRANT

- Coaches register with USA Rugby AND Utah Youth Rugby
- Coaches sign up and pay the USA Rugby clinic fee of \$110
- Complete 100 requirements
- Attend clinic
- Apply for grant of \$110 once active Level 200 per USA Rugby
- UYR mails check to coach



### 2016 / 2017 FIELD GRANT

- Covers the cost of field rental, goal posts and paint
- Club responsible for setup, including painting lines, of field
- Club responsible for take down of fields
- UYR will contract directly with cities for fields
- UYR will reimburse for other expenses actually paid by club
- UYR may place sponsor banners and charge gate
- Clubs can elect to keep gate and forgo the Field Grant



### 2016 / 2017 ROOKIE RUGBY LEAGUE GRANT

- Community / City based flag league for boys and girls in K-8
- USA Rugby and UYR registered Level 100 certified coach required
- Community requests grant through UYR
- League organizer
  - Arranges field / facility
  - Recruits players
- Participants register with UYR as Rookie Rugby members (\$35)
- League organizer may add a league fee to the UYR fee



### 2016 / 2017 ROOKIE RUGBY LEAGUE GRANT

- UYR provides the following for each 4 team (40 players) league
  - Rookie Rugby T-Shirt for each participant
  - Rookie Rugby training session for all league coaches
  - Ball bag
  - Bibs
  - Flags
  - Cones
  - Ten balls
  - Three printed coaching manuals
  - League admin manual






# 2016 / 2017 INCOME BUDGET SUMMARY






## 2016 / 2017 PROGRAM EXPENSES FUNDING

## 2016 / 2017 Club Registration
