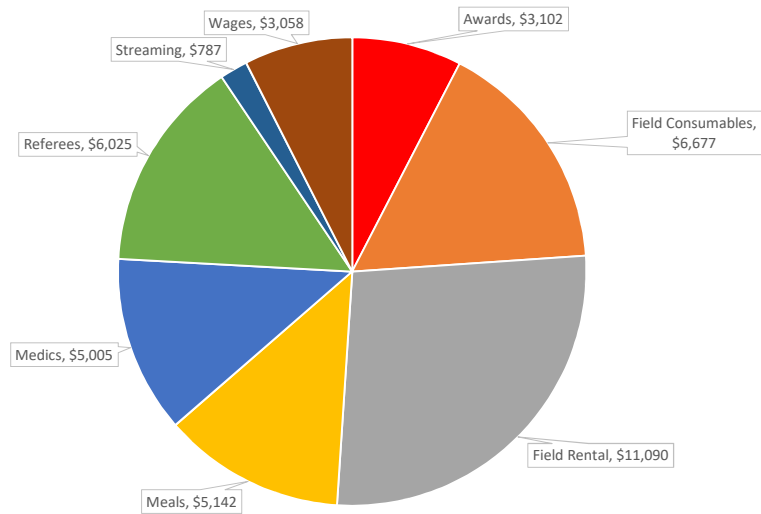


2017 HIGH SCHOOL FALL 7s

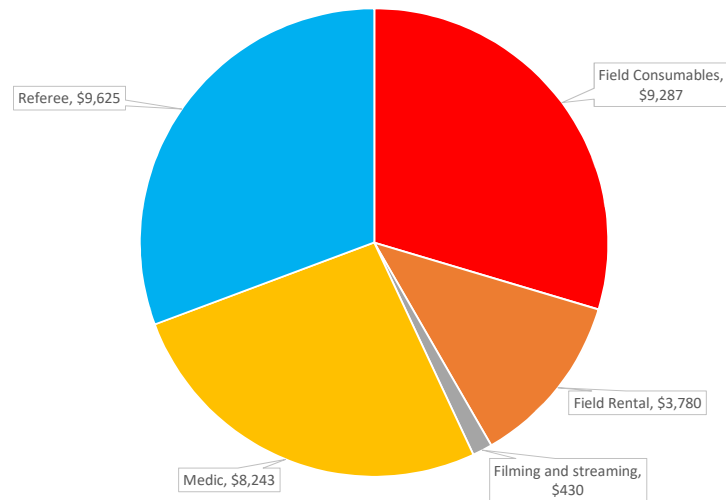

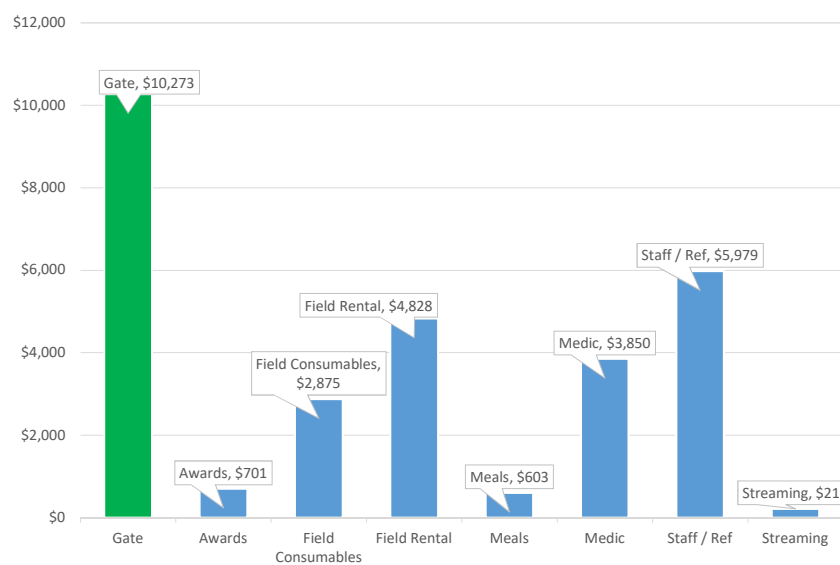

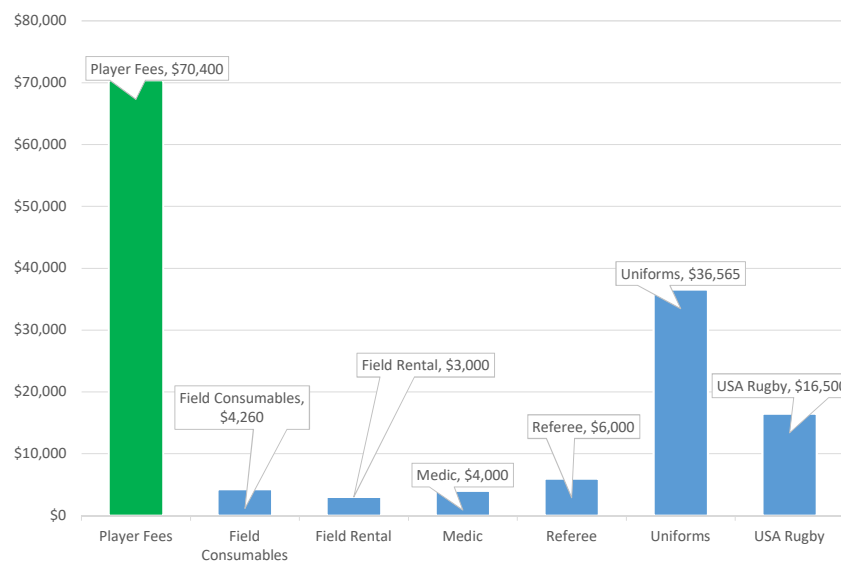


2018 LITTLE RUGBY LEAGUE

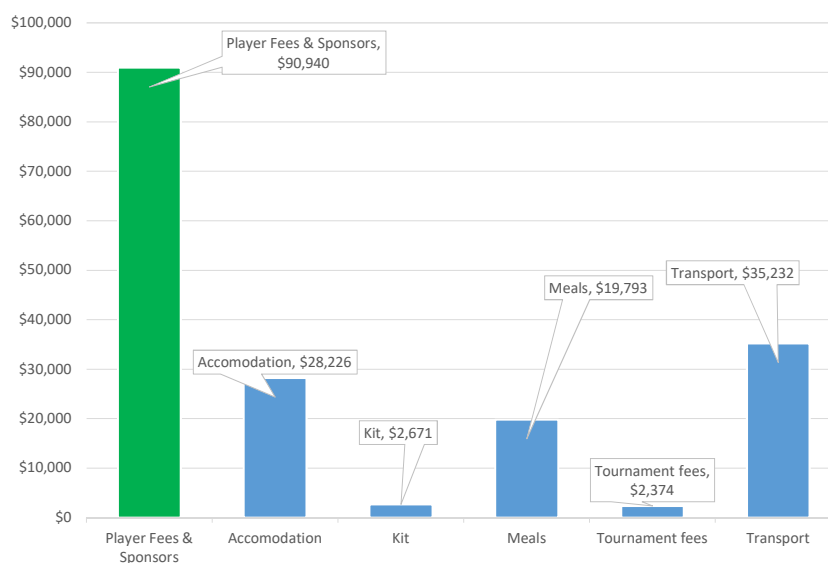

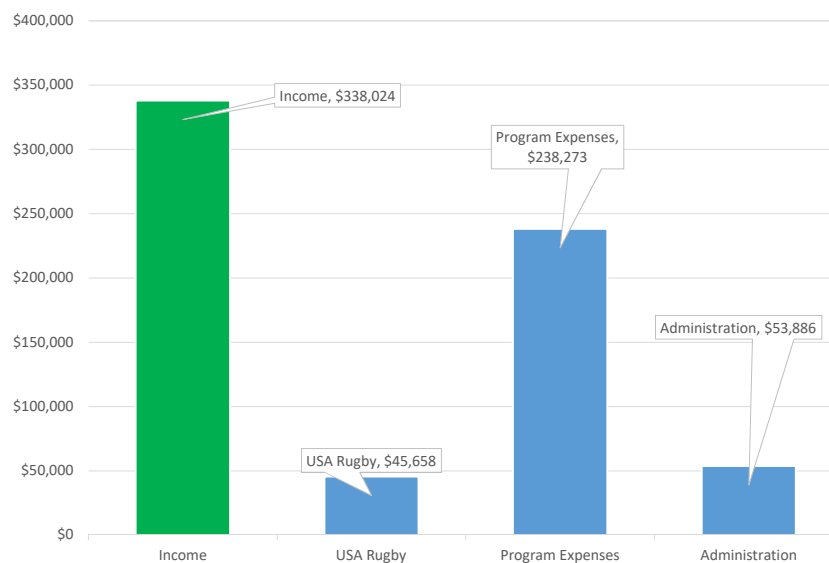

2018 / 2019 Club Registration

- Through Utah Youth Rugby only
- \$100 collected at registration
 - Boys HS
 - Girls HS
 - Middle School (Youth)
- Registration will open on August 1st
- Club uploads a .eps / pdf (vector files) of club logos



2018 / 2019 Season Team Registration

- Each season will have its own registration
- \$50 per team entered collected at registration
- Fall 7s registration will open August 1st
- Spring 15s registration will open September 15th



2018 / 2019 High School and Middle School Player Registration

- \$135 Annual Player Fee – Covers both Fall 7s and Spring 15s
- Fee is NON-REFUNDABLE
- Payment plan
 - \$65 at registration
 - \$35 for 2 months
- Added club dues are spread over the three payments
- Registration will open on August 1st
- Player uploads:
 - Current school ID card
 - Proof of current school registration



2019 Little League Player Registration

- Player Fee
 - Early Bird - \$110 (From January 1, 2018)
 - Regular - \$130 (From March 1, 2018)
 - Late - \$150 (From April 1, 2018)
- Fee is NON-REFUNDABLE
- NO Payment plan
- Player uploads:
 - School photo
 - Proof of current school registration





Boys Spring 15s League



General Approach

- One 15s Season for the Boys League (Mid-March to Mid-May)
- League comprises conferences by age divisions – 7/8 Grade, 9/10 Grade and 11/12 Grade
- One set of boys policies to govern all conferences in the league
- Team eligibility policies
- Team conference choice with responsibilities
- Player movement allowed but restricted
- Conferences organized with like teams in roster makeup and strength



Team Eligibility

- Eligibility for each conference determined by
 - Club status with school if affiliated with a school or not
 - Core school representation on each team roster
 - Club with age based teams – 7/8, 9/10 and 11/12
- Red Conference follows USA Rugby Team Eligibility rule
 - Team must be represented by a roster that is limited to: players that are registered students at the High School upon which the team is based including home schooled students eligible for that school's athletic activities
- All other conferences for teams choosing not to be bound by the above eligibility rule



Play Where You Live

- 7th Graders and new players (Grades 8 and up) are required to join the club that
 - Has a team for their age; and
 1. That is affiliated with the high school zoned for their residential address; or
 2. The nearest to where they live if not zoned for a high school with a team
- Waiver process available if desired
 - Written application required (with a fee)
 - Committee reviewed
 - Approved or denied
- That club becomes their primary home club and remain with that club throughout school career no matter what team they were or will / may be eligible for in the future
- Transfer rules apply after joining primary home club



Player Transfers

- Only one player transfer request available in 6 year period
- Apply by last day of February before season starts
- New players transfer request is considered used whether or not waiver is allowed
- Additional transfers allowed when
 - Primary home club disbands;
 - Player transfers schools; or
 - Player's residential address changes



Field Management

- Technical Zones
- Coaches – Badged
- Players - Dressed
- Field Signage
- 4th Official
 - UYR Employed (drawn from clubs)
 - Roster checks
- Certified touch judges – clubs provide
- Game film



Conferences

- Conferences for league play by roster make up
 - Red
 - Blue / White
 - Green – if needed for new teams
- Minimum 6 team conference – combine as needed
- 9/10 and 7/8 follow Varsity



League Play

- Conferences may not be larger than 6 teams each
- Conferences with more than 6 teams are divided with the higher seeded teams being in the higher division
- Teams play all teams in the conference for division standings purposes
- Teams may play additional teams from other conferences to make up 5 league matches if needed for division standings purposes
- All matches in excess of 5 are considered friendlies and only affect overall league standings
- UYR may limit total number of matches per team



State Championships

- Teams in each conference division compete in a State Championship playoff following the regular season
- Combine tiers across conferences as needed to form championship brackets of up to 6 teams
- 9/10 and 7/8 follow Varsity



Club / Team Management

- Register team by November 1st, 2018 to be included on schedule
- Register 15 players with UYR by February 1st, 2019 to stay on schedule
 - \$500 deposit to hold spot if less than 15 registered
 - Refund deposit if 15 registered by March 1st, 2019;
 - Play all scheduled matches; and
 - Attend all meetings
- Match no show penalties (less than 1 week notice) - \$120 to cover ref and medic fees
